HISTORY - The Mountain Garden Club was founded in 1973. In 1976 we became a Federated member of the NH Federation of Garden Clubs – District 1, National Garden Clubs, Inc. and New England Garden Clubs, Inc.

The Mountain Garden Club (MGC) is a registered Non-Profit 501(c)(3) organization.

MEETING SCHEDULE - we meet on Mondays, once a month, September to June (see back for schedule). There are no business meetings in the summer months to allow members to devote time to other projects, Valley Beautification Sites, and their own gardens.

PROGRAMS -

presented at our monthly meetings, provide many educational opportunities for members on a varying number of subjects from a wide variety of experts in their respective fields.

ACTIVITIES -

The Mountain Garden Club sponsors: Scholarships for students interested in any form of Environmental or Horticulture related study, Flower Sales at our annual Winter Boutique and Spring Plant Sale, and "Art In Bloom" floral design exhibits. Our fundraiser events help support the scholarship fund, special community projects, and also provides funding for our regular programs which are open to our members and the public.

The Mountain Garden Club members routinely organize special trips to public and private gardens, museums and flower shows (as a member social activity).

Members actively participate in Valley Beautification Site projects which include: roadside beautification, planting and maintaining public properties in summer, and holiday decorating in winter.

Among our many community projects are: working with Habitat for Humanity, maintaining a rain garden at Children Unlimited, and the gardens at Merriman House. We work with the local High School on horticulture and Elementary schools on conservation education through the Smokey Bear/Woodsy Owl poster program. We also work with Story Land to prep gardens prior to opening for a donation to our Scholarship fund. Summer months include some "Special Event" activities which are publicized by email and on our website.
